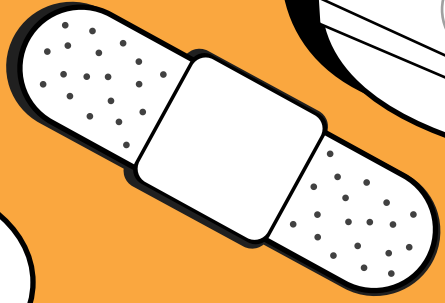

(Luke 10:30-37, New International Reader's Version)

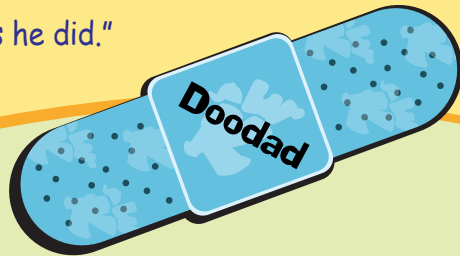

Jesus told him, "Go and do as he did."

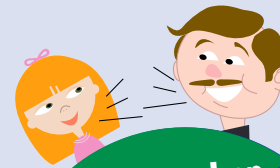


Application Points

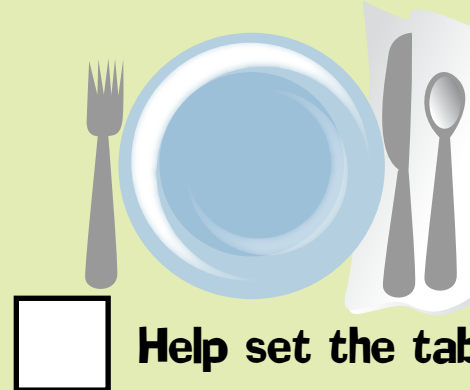
