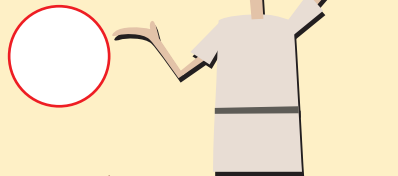
Fear can distract us from having a heart after God.

David carrying some cheese



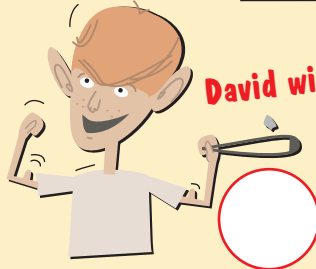
David sees Goliath
