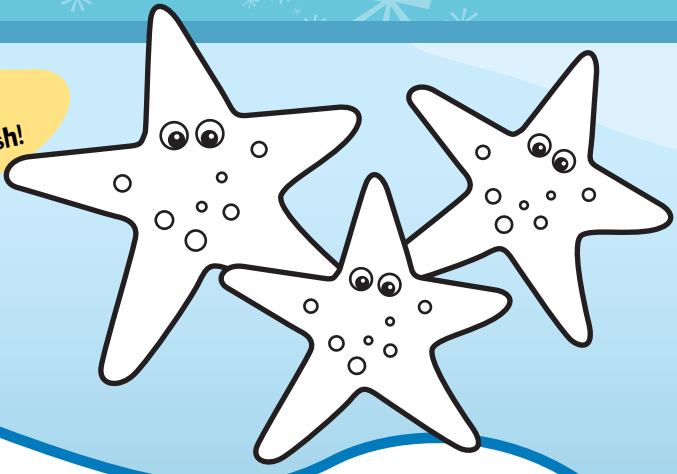


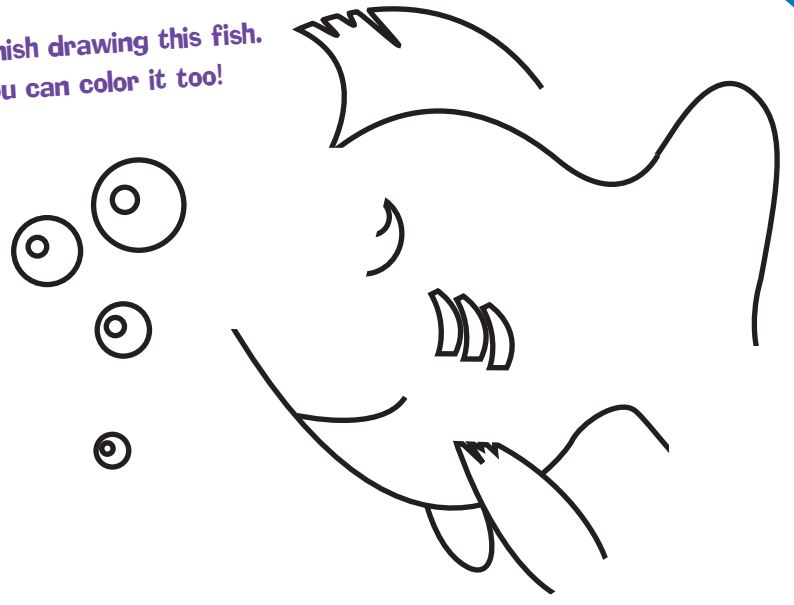

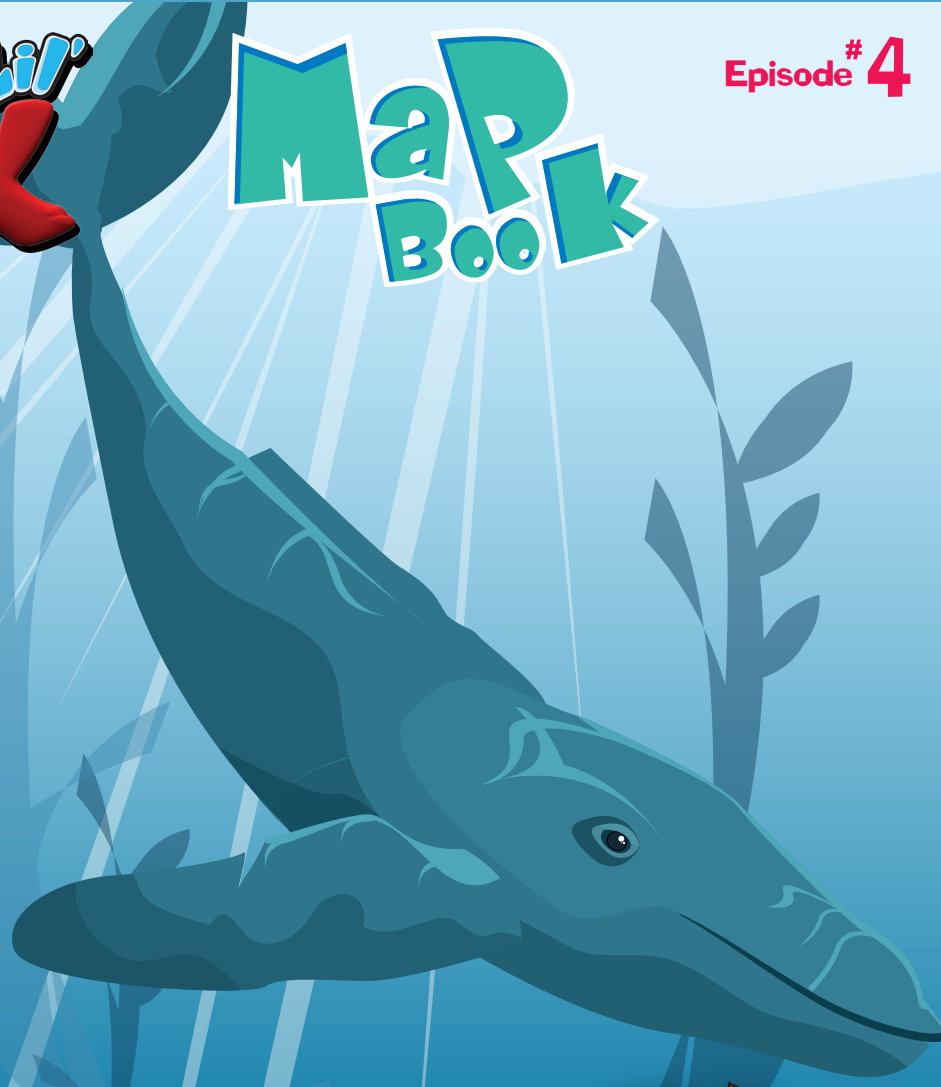

"Ta-Da! Look what God made!"

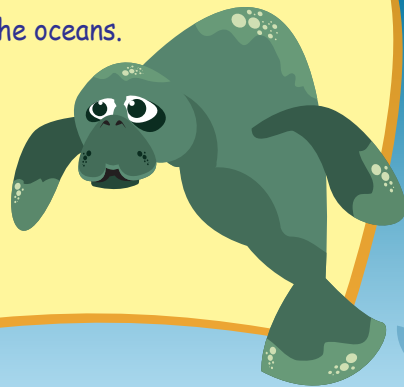




Genesis 1:20-23

Practice the Remember Verse with your mom or dad. Make up hand motions to go along with it.

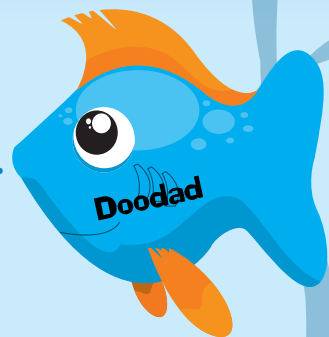
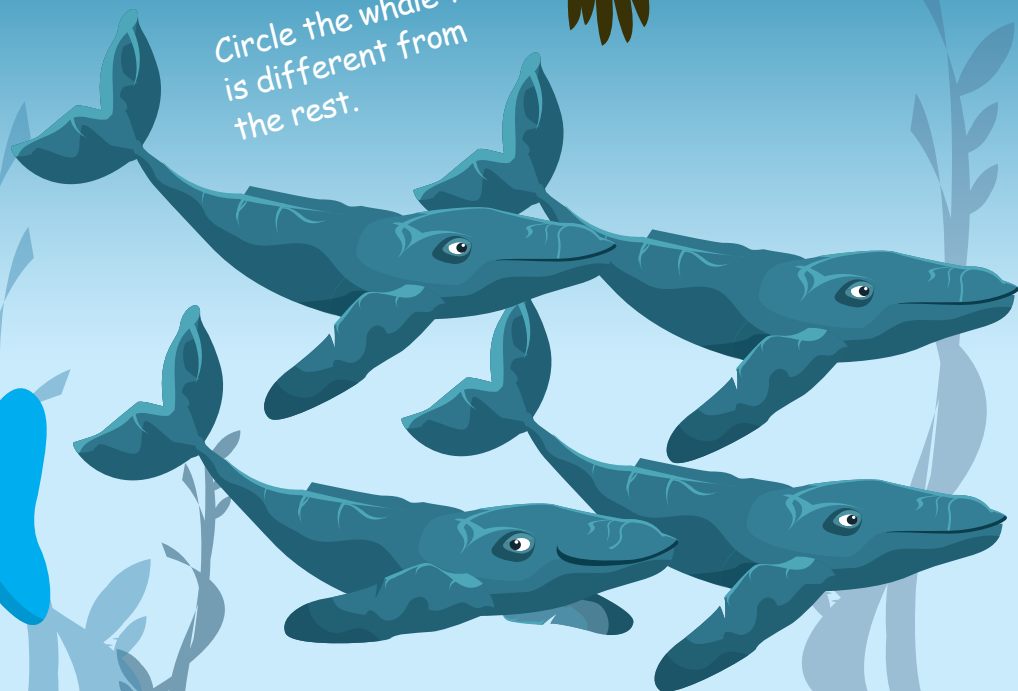


Can you find Lil'K?
