Morning Prayer

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (HCSB)

¹⁶ All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness, ¹⁷ so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

I am persuaded; God Almighty made the heavens, the earth and all that is in them.

Colossians 1:16-17 (NIV)

¹⁶ For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. ¹⁷ He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

Mid-Day Prayer

I am persuaded; I have been reconciled to God, accepted and approved by Him.

Colossians 1:21-22 (NIV)

- ²¹ Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior.
- ²² But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation--

I am persuaded; I have been delivered from the domain of darkness. I belong to the eternal kingdom of God. I have been redeemed and forgiven.

Colossians 1:13-14 (NASB)

¹³ For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

I am persuaded; Jesus is returning to the earth, triumphant. He will reward those who have honored him and bring judgment against those who have rejected him.

Revelation 1:5-7 (NIV)

Look, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him; and all the peoples of the earth will mourn because of him. So shall it be! Amen.

Evening Prayer

I am persuaded; Jesus is building his church and I intend to assist in every possible way. Matthew 16:18-19 (NIV)

. . .I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. ¹⁹ I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

I am persuaded; to honor God with my life—with all my heart, mind, soul and body. I will invest my time, my treasure and my talent as an expression of honor to my Lord and King.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (NIV)

19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.

I am persuaded; I will endure, persevere, complete my course AND receive the reward which the Lord, the righteous judge will present.

2 Timothy 2:3, 4:6-8 (NIV)

³ Endure hardship with us like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. . . . ⁶ For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time has come for my departure. ⁷ I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. ⁸ Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day--and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

I am persuaded; God has made complete provision for my life in time and eternity. In Christ I have been given everything I need to overcome, be victorious and demonstrate the faithfulness of my God.
