ALLEN JACKSON:

The son of an equine veterinarian, Pastor Allen Jackson often jokes that he was "raised in a barn," but his life has proven to be impactful. He and his wife, Kathy, live near Nashville, Tennessee, where he has served as senior pastor of World Outreach Church since 1989. Under his leadership, the inter-denominational church has grown from less than 30 people to over 15,000 local congregants. He still fondly refers to the congregation as a "little country church" because that's how it began—as a small Bible study in his parents' home in the 1970s.

His mission is to help people become more fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ, and technology has increased his impact, allowing his biblical messages to reach and encourage 3,000,000+ people per week through Allen Jackson Ministries. Pastor Allen holds degrees from Oral Roberts University and Vanderbilt University, and has studied at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary and Hebrew University in Jerusalem.
