Ephesians 1:7 (NIV84®)

⁷ In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace

1 John 1:7 (NIV84®)

⁷ But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

Because I walk in the light, in fellowship with believers; the blood of Jesus continually cleanses me from all sin.

Romans 5:9 (NIV84®)

⁹ Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!

Through the blood of Jesus, I am justified—acquitted, not guilty, made righteous—just as if I'd never sinned.

EVENING PRAYER

Hebrews 13:12 (NIV84®)

¹² And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy (sanctify) through his own blood.

Through the blood of Jesus, I am sanctified—made holy, set apart to God—separated from all sin.

Ephesians 2:12–13 (NIV84®)

¹² Remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. ¹³ But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ.

Through the blood of Jesus, I am being made near to God.

Hebrews 10:19–22 (NIV84®)

¹⁹ Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, ²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.

Through the blood of Jesus, I have confidence to enter the holy place, to enter the immediate presence of God.
